- · Livestock competition is limited to Carver and adjoining counties, restriction of entries may be imposed.
- · Livestock exhibitors are responsible for the care of their exhibit.
- · Poultry exhibitors will have feed and care provided by Carver County fair staff.
- · All barns/cages/pens on the premise have been sanitized with approved sanitation methods.
- · A veterinarian is employed by the Carver County Agriculture Society to review animal health, determine if an entry meets all standards required for exhibition. The designated veterinarian has the authority to remove any animal that does not meet requirements of exhibition.
